

Terms of Service

Effective March 22, 2026

Introduction

These Terms of Service (“Terms”) govern your access to and use of the software, websites, and services provided by Adjoint (“we,” “our,” or “us”), including Adjoint: AI Copilot for Unity (collectively, the “Service”). By accessing or using the Service, you agree to be bound by these Terms. If you do not agree, you may not use the Service.

Eligibility

You must be at least 13 years old to use the Service. If you are using the Service on behalf of an organization, you represent that you have the authority to bind that organization to these Terms, and “you” refers to both you and that organization.

Accounts

To access certain features, you may be required to create an account. You agree to:

- Provide accurate, current, and complete information during registration.
- Maintain the security and confidentiality of your account credentials.
- Promptly notify us of any unauthorized access or use of your account.
- Accept responsibility for all activities that occur under your account.

The Service generates output using artificial intelligence (“Output”). Subject to these Terms, you own the Output you generate and may use it commercially. Output may be non-unique or inaccurate and must be reviewed before use. You are responsible for evaluating its suitability and legality.

The Service, including software, design, trademarks, and related intellectual property, is owned by Adjoint or its licensors. No rights are granted except as expressly stated in these Terms.

Third-Party Services

The Service may integrate third-party services. Your use of such services is subject to their terms. We are not responsible for third-party services.

Fees and Billing

Some features may require payment. Fees and billing terms are disclosed at purchase. Fees are non-refundable unless required by law. We may change pricing with notice where required. You are responsible for taxes.
